The ASGBC elections process has come to a close, and the ASGBC Electoral Committee has ratified the following results.

In total, there were 1339 votes cast in this years election (a 30% increase over last years turnout).

ASGBC Presidential Race

Jory Hamilton	398	29.57%
Daniel Ngoy	783	58.53%
Choose not to vote for position	157	11.73%

Daniel Ngoy has been elected to serve as the ASGBC President for the 2024-2025 academic year, as he won 58.53% of the vote. Congratulations to Daniel!

ASGBC Vice Presidential Race
